Dear Professor Tsenev,

We currently have a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between AIHA and the the Bulgarian Occupational Hygiene Association (BOHA). AIHA has many similar MOUs with other organizations, documents that describe a spirit of cooperation that would exist between our organizations even without a signed statement.

What these MOUs do not contain are any measurable outcomes or joint efforts in which we are engaged. Rather than maintain these broad statements of recognition, we are taking steps to cancel these agreements with the understanding that AIHA will continue to support the principles they describe. As we identify opportunities for our respective organizations to collaborate on specific projects, we will create new documents outlining those efforts and the points to which we agree to at that time.

We are therefore cancelling the Memorandum of Understanding with BOHA signed on 29 February 2008, with the understanding that AIHA remains open to finding opportunities to work together to accomplish our mutual goals.
